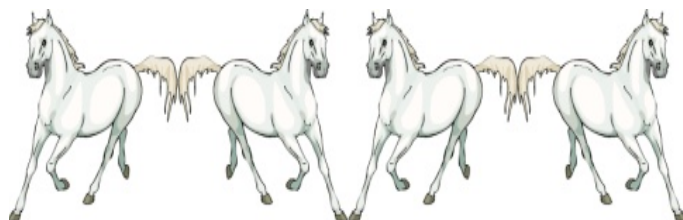

POP QUIZ ANSWER~

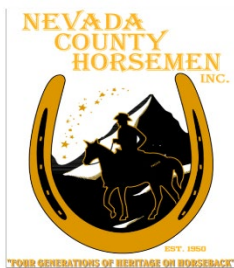
