### **POP QUIZ ANSWER~**

**Horse's ears can move 180 degrees using 10 different muscles. Human ears have 3 muscles. Horses can hear as far away as 4 km (almost 2.5 miles). Horses can hear higher frequencies. This allows them to detect ultrasonic the shriek of a bat. (inaudible to a human ear). Common positions of a horse's ear can tell you if they are afraid, alert, friendly, angry, unhappy, in pain or relaxed.**
